

**Florida College Equality in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA)
Report for the 2018-2019 Academic Year**

For the 2018-2019 Academic Year, Florida College had 236 male full-time undergraduate students and 258 female full-time undergraduate students for a total of 494 students. Our athletic teams competed as part of the NAIA.

Florida College had both men's and women's intercollegiate athletic teams. Our men's teams included cross country, track (long distance), basketball, and soccer. Our women's teams included cross country, track (long distance), basketball, soccer, and volleyball.

The following number of varsity athletes participated in each program:
