

# FLORIDA COLLEGE *Dual Enrollment* RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE

This is a recommended sequence, but courses may be taken in any order. High school students who follow the recommended sequence of Florida College dual enrollment course can enter Florida College with 32 college credits completed. If you live outside of Florida, check with your state for high school credit equivalents.

## 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Spring

**ARH 1051: Art History II**  
College Credit – 3 hours of Humanities Credit  
Florida High School – 0.5 Fine Arts Credit

## 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Fall

**MAC 1105: College Algebra**  
College Credit – 3 hours of Mathematics Credit  
Florida High School – 1.0 Mathematics Credit

**SPN 1120: Elementary Spanish I**  
College Credit – 4 hours of Foreign Languages Credit  
Florida High School – 1.0 World Languages Credit

**STA 2023: Introductory Statistics**  
College Credit – 3 hours of Mathematics Credit  
Florida High School – 1.0 Mathematics Credit

College Credit – 4 hours of Foreign Languages Credit  
Florida High School – 1.0 World Languages Credit
